Councilmember McClure moved to cast the city of Azle votes for all the incumbent candidates. Mayor Pro tem Jones seconded the motion.

- Sixty and Better and the Senior Center are facing some changes due to COVID-19. Meals on Wheels will deliver meals to the Senior Center.

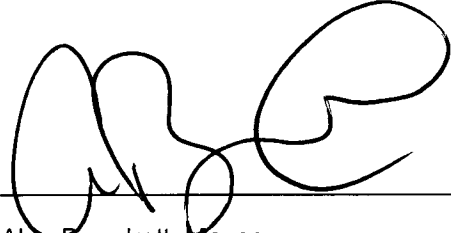
MAYOR/COUNCIL COMMENTS

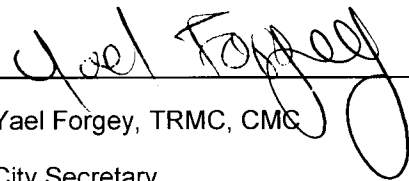
