2. Present library usage statistics

Curren McLane presented library usage statistics. October's statistics were very similar to September's, except for programs. October had a total of 10 programs with an attendance of 240, whereas September had a total of 6 programs with an attendance of 64.

3. Present information about past and upcoming programs and events

Curren McLane presented current and upcoming programming. Past programs include the dinosaur show on November 9th with 99 people in attendance. Other October programs included social security 101, fall garden prep, and Pokémon club. Upcoming programs include Grinchmas celebration, fall

vegetable gardening, mushroom lanterns, winter trees, paper bag snowflakes, LEGO club, Main St. book club, last Monday matinée, holiday pajama Storytime, and Dino Storytime. Storytime will pause between November 21st through January 8th due to scheduling conflicts. The Grinchmas celebration will take place on December 12 and is expected to have a few hundred people in attendance.

4. Present building updates

Curren McLane stated there is an HVAC component that is down that is preventing certain areas from warming properly. It is being worked on, but it may take some time as parts are difficult to find.
