DISCUSSION ITEMS

2. Possible projects

Board Members discussed possible projects around the city, which included a possible mural on the old "Slice" building on Main Street with a Western motif or an "I Love Azle" design, installing a flower bed in the median at North Stewart and Northwest Parkway, and installing a flower bed around the lightbox at the intersection of FM730N and SH199. TxDOT will need to be contacted for approval of either of these flower bed projects since this is in TxDOT right-of-way. Board Members discussed amendments to the Facade Grant, i.e., increasing reimbursement funds for Main Street projects, exploring the possibility of funding up to 100% of a project for businesses, and waiving all permits. Staff will present their suggestions to City Council for review.

3. Keep Texas Beautiful

City Manager Muir informed the Board that the membership fee for becoming a "Keep Texas Beautiful"

affiliate is \$200. The Board agreed to join the program. Mr Muir advised bylaws will need to be drafted, and he will present these at the next meeting.
