Agenda Item: TxDOT's Green Ribbon Program

Background and Explanation:

At the last Board meeting, the Board expressed a desire to beautify Boyd Rd. (FM730N), underneath SH199. Staff explored possibilities and found out the proposed project would fit into TxDOT's Green Ribbon Program but the deadline to submit projects had already passed (March 28th). In discussing the project with TxDOT, they encouraged us to submit the proposed project but it needed to be submitted quickly.

Therefore, Staff moved quickly to submit an application for grant funding through the FY2026 TxDOT Green Ribbon Program to enhance the intersection of SH199 and Boyd Rd. (FM730N). On June 6th, Staff received a letter from TxDOT approving funding in a fixed amount of up to \$400,000. This award is tentative, pending execution of an Advanced Funding Agreement and a Landscape Maintenance Agreement.
