Mayor Goode recognized Assistant to the City Manager Susie Hiles, who advised that CWD was requesting an increase in the sludge disposal rate from \$1819.70/load to \$1,985.93/load (an 8.7% increase). The requested price adjustment is due to an increase in landfill cost, as well as increases in the CPI index and fuel costs.
